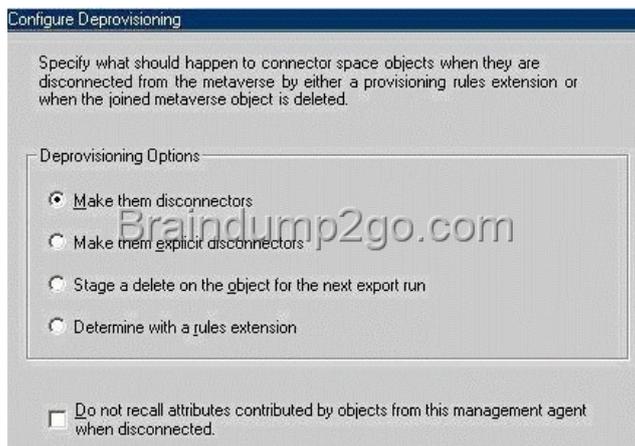

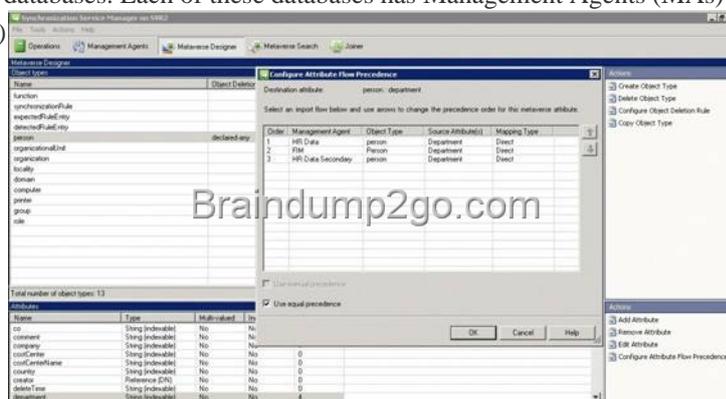
QUESTION 34 Active Screen Question This type of question asks you to configure a dialog box. You indicate the correct answer by changing one or more elements in the dialog box. To set your answer

- Option buttons and check boxes To select an option button or check box in the dialog box in the work area: Click the option button or check box. Click the text following the option button or check box.
- To clear an option button: Click another option button within the same group. Click the text of another option button within the same group.
- To clear a check box: Click the selected check box. Click the text of the selected check box.
- List boxes To select an item from a list in the dialog box in the work area: Click the item. Use Shift+Click or Ctrl+Click to select multiple items in the list box. This feature functions only when the list box can accept multiple selections.
- Drop-down list boxes To select an item from a drop-down list in the dialog box in the work area: Click the arrow on the drop-down list box. Select an item on the list that appears.
- Text boxes To fill in a text box in the dialog box in the work area: Drag the appropriate text element from the source area to the text box. To remove the text from a text box: Drag the text element back to the source area. Select the text element and press the Delete key. To replace the text in a text box: Drag another text element to the text box.
- Spin boxes To select a value in a spin box in the dialog box in the work area: Click the arrows to select the appropriate value. To remove all changes you made: Click the Reset button. The elements in the dialog box will return to their original state.

Notes Note the following considerations when answering this type of question: You might need to use the scroll bar to view the entire contents of the question. You might need to use the scroll bar to view the entire contents of the panes in the work area. You can use the splitter bar to resize the panes. In some Active Screen questions, not all elements in the dialog box are active. Active Screen questions are not a complete simulation of the actual environment. Therefore, the results of your actions might not be the same as in the actual product. For example, a change might not occur in an element that normally becomes enabled or disabled when an option is selected. You create an Active Directory Management Agent (AD MA) to manage users and groups between the two directory services.
